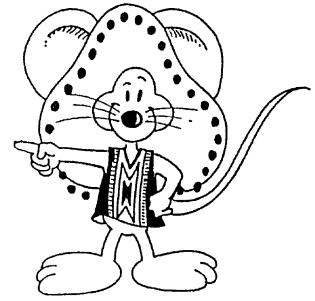


# Beekmantown High School Classroom Behavior Rules

## Spanish 2 (HN) / 3 (HN) - Mr. Madan 2005-2006



In each of my classes it is important that you, the student, have the opportunity to learn and that I, the teacher, am able to teach you to the best of my ability. In order for this to happen, there must be order and students must be able to hear and ask questions with no disruptions. With this in mind, the following (4) rules and consequences apply while you are in my classroom:

### **RULE**

### **CONSEQUENCES**

(1) Students are to arrive to class BEFORE the bell rings.

Students without a valid pass or excuse will receive an office referral for every three tardies resulting in lunch and/or afterschool detention.

(2) Students are to arrive to class with the necessary materials. (Pens, notebooks, text or workbook, etc.)

Unprepared students will spend the class period without the materials. The student may receive a "0" for classwork assigned that day. Repeat offenders will receive an office referral for insubordination.

(3) Students will refrain from disrupting the class.

During the same class period:

1st Violation - The student will be given a warning.

2nd Violation - The student will be assigned to after school detention for 40 minutes and a parent or guardian will be contacted.

3rd Violation - The student will be expelled from the class and assigned to Structured Study Hall for the remainder of the period.

Any student that continues to disrupt class on a regular basis will receive an office referral under the corresponding step and may be assigned to Structured Study Hall until the situation has been resolved with a parent or guardian.

(4) Students will respect the teacher, classmates and their property, and the school's property.

The student may be expelled from class immediately and referred to the Principal's office. The student may not be allowed to return to class until a parent/teacher conference has been held. Furthermore, any student who intentionally damages school property will make amends during after school hours.

In addition to these rules, any student who receives (3) office referrals for misbehavior in class may be removed from the class for the remainder of the school year.
