

Creating Spanish Special Characters in a Mac

Type the key combinations below in the order listed.

For accented letters: you must keep the Option key held down, then type the underlined letter, and finally let go of both keys and type the actual letter that should have the accent:

á = Option + e(let go of both keys)..... a

é = Option + e(let go of both keys)..... e

í = Option + e(let go of both keys)..... i

ó = Option + e(let go of both keys)..... o

ú = Option + e(let go of both keys)..... u

Note that “e” is always used after Option regardless of the letter accentuated. Only vowels can have accents.

For the remaining characters:

ñ = Option + n(let go of both keys)..... n

¿ = Option + Shift + ?

¡ = Option + !
