

In Microsoft Windows this is how you enter Spanish characters with accents:

Make sure Num Lock is On, and use the numbers on the keypad. Hold down the Alt Key and while still holding it, type the numbers below. You do not have to hold down any of the numbers.

(Only use the numbers on the right side of the keyboard or as indicated on a laptop keyboard)

$\tilde{N} = \text{Alt} + 164$

$\acute{U} = \text{Alt} + 163$

$\acute{O} = \text{Alt} + 162$

$\acute{I} = \text{Alt} + 161$

$\acute{A} = \text{Alt} + 160$

$\acute{E} = \text{Alt} + 130$

$\grave{c} = \text{Alt} + 168$

$\grave{i} = \text{Alt} + 0161$
