

El pretérito – Ir y ser

Preterite Tense – Ir & Ser

Ir and Ser have the same forms in the Preterite Tense

Ir		Ser	
fui <i>I went</i>	fuimos <i>We went</i>	fui <i>I was</i>	fuimos <i>We were</i>
fuiste <i>You went (familiar)</i>	fuisteis <i>You went (plural)</i>	fuiste <i>You were (familiar)</i>	fuisteis <i>You were (plural)</i>
fue <i>You went (formal) He/She went</i>	fueron <i>You went (plural) They went</i>	fue <i>You were (formal) He/She was</i>	fueron <i>You were (plural) They were</i>

The context of the sentence will usually tell which verb is being used.

- Yo **fui** al supermercado esta mañana.
I went to the supermarket this morning.
- **Fue** una película muy aburrida.
It was a very boring movie.
