 Review- Reflexive Verbs

In Spanish, an action that a subject performs on or for his or her self is considered reflexive. To express this action, a reflexive pronoun is placed before the verb in a sentence.

Los pronombres....

Subject Pronoun	Reflexive Pronoun
yo	me
tú	te
ud./él/ella	se
nosotros(as)	nos
vosotros(as)	os
uds./ellos/ellas	se

The same verb can be used in reflexive or non-reflexive situations.

Non-Reflexive	Reflexive
Compro una revista. <i>I am buying a magazine.</i>	Me compro una revista. <i>I am buying myself a magazine.</i>
Inés lava el coche. <i>Inés is washing the car.</i>	Inés se lava el pelo. <i>Inés is washing her hair.</i>
Miramos la televisión. <i>We are watching television.</i>	Nos miramos en el espejo. <i>We look at ourselves in the mirror.</i>

The reflexive pronoun corresponds to the subject and is placed immediately before the verb in a one-verb sentence:

Yo me baño a las seis.

I bathe at six.

Unlike subject pronouns, reflexive pronouns are **REQUIRED** in a sentence.

In more complex sentences, the reflexive pronoun can be attached to the end of an infinitive or participle.

Voy a bañarme a las seis.

I'm going to bathe at six.

Estoy bañándome ahora mismo.

I'm taking a bath right now.

Reflexive pronouns can correspond to the English:
myself/yourself/his(her)self,
ourselves, themselves.

Reflexive verbs are identified by the "**se**" attached to the end of the infinitive:
 ducharse, peinarse, vestirse, etc.

Ejemplos

lavarse (to wash one's self)

yo	me lavo	nosotros nosotras	nos lavamos
tú	te lavas	vosotros vosotras	os laváis
ud. él/ella	se lava	uds. ellos/ellas	se lavan

Otro ejemplo

Ponerse (to put on one's self)

yo	me pongo	nosotros nosotras	nos ponemos
tú	te pones	vosotros vosotras	os ponéis
ud. él/ella	se pone	uds. ellos/ellas	se ponen

Y un ejemplo final

Irse (to leave)

yo	me voy	nosotros nosotras	nos vamos
tú	te vas	vosotros vosotras	os vais
ud. él/ella	se va	uds. ellos/ellas	se van
