

Español 3 – Sr. Madan Honors Challenges –Writing & Reading

2nd Quarter

Challenge Topic: *Written Discussion*

Challenge Objective:

A student should be able to contribute to a basic, online (written) discussion in Spanish.

Challenge Requirements:

Online Spanish Discussion

You must participate in an informal, online discussion using the Honors Online Discussion Area on www.SpanishPlanet.org or through the BCS web site:
<http://faculty.bcsdk12.org/education/staff/staff.php?sectionid=322>

Once a week a new Board will be created by Mr. Madan and you are expected to contribute a response in Spanish at least twice a week or a total of at least 10 responses by the end of the quarter, January 25, 2008.

Here are the guidelines for what may be posted and what will receive credit:

- All responses will first go to Mr. Madan automatically before being cleared for posting on the Honors Online Discussion Area.
- Follow the attached instructions on “How to Post”. Please **do not** enter your full, real name. Follow the attached instructions and enter your Spanish name as a first name and the first letter of your last name as your last name. This will be the only identifier that displays in the Discussion Area.
- You must respond **in Spanish** and it must relate to the overall thread being discussed. Responses should be complete sentences and comprehensible. One word responses will not count toward the minimum. You may respond to a previous posting or create a new Subject for a Thread. The Thread must relate to the Category of the Board. You will be graded primarily on the content of what you post.
- Students will not give out any personal information about themselves nor any other individual. Postings containing such information will be automatically rejected by Mr. Madan.
- Students may only refer to other students in the discussion by username (Spanish first name and last initial). Responses that contain inflammatory, insulting or malicious content directed at any one will be rejected and the student may be referred to the High School Administration for disciplinary action. This will automatically disqualify a student from the Honors program.
- Students will abide by the BCS Acceptable Use Policy at all times when participating in these discussions.

As you complete this challenge, pay attention to the Grading Rubric on the back of this sheet. You must earn at least a **2** in order to receive credit and remain in the Honors Program.
